## Jean - Pierre - Frédéric BARROIS

PARIS 1786 - MEAUX 1847

A pupil of Fontallard and Hersent, he exhibited at the Paris Salons from 1806 to 1841. Besides his miniatures we have by him the portrait of a saint, now in Clermont cathedral.
